



Associated Students of Rogue Community College (ASGRCC) Executive Council Officer Positions Overview with Link to Full Position Descriptions

President Position Overview (12 hrs/wk):

The ASGRCC President serves as the chief executive student leader for Rogue Community College and is responsible for guiding the vision, direction, and effectiveness of the Associated Student Government. As the primary representative of the student body, the President advocates for student needs, maintains strong working relationships with college administration, and ensures that student voices are included in institutional decision-making. The President oversees the ASGRCC Executive Council, chairs ASGRCC meetings, upholds and interprets governing documents, and ensures that all ASGRCC initiatives align with the mission and best interests of RCC students. This position also represents ASGRCC at campus and community functions, collaborates with state-level organizations, and ensures transparent, ethical, and accountable student governance.

Vice President of Clubs & Student Organizations Position Overview (12 hrs/wk):

The ASGRCC Vice President of Clubs & Student Organizations provides leadership and oversight for all ASGRCC-recognized clubs and club-related programming at Rogue Community College. This role supports the development, success, and visibility of student clubs by guiding club leaders, coordinating major club events, and ensuring compliance with ASGRCC policies and procedures. The ASGRCC Vice President of Clubs & Student Organizations chairs the Inter-Club Council (ICC), fosters collaboration among student organizations, and works closely with ASGRCC officers and Student Life staff to strengthen co-curricular engagement across RCC campuses. Through active communication, event support, and organizational leadership, the ASGRCC Vice President of Clubs & Student Organizations plays a key role in cultivating an inclusive and vibrant student club community.

ASGRCC Vice President of Student Engagement Position Overview (12 hrs/wk):

The ASGRCC Vice President of Student Engagement leads campus-wide efforts to enhance student involvement, community building, and co-curricular engagement at Rogue Community College. Serving as the chair of the ASGRCC Student Activities Programming Board, this role oversees the planning, promotion, and execution of student events that support a vibrant, inclusive, and connected campus environment. The ASGRCC VP of Student Engagement collaborates closely with ASGRCC officers, Student Life staff, college departments, and student organizations to coordinate high-quality activities that reflect student needs and interests. This position also ensures consistent documentation, communication, and evaluation of events, and plays a key role in strengthening student engagement across RCC's campuses.

Communications Coordinator Position Overview (10 hrs/wk):

The ASGRCC Communications Coordinator is responsible for managing, organizing, and distributing information on behalf of ASGRCC to ensure students, staff, and faculty are informed about campus events, club activities, and student-government initiatives. This role oversees marketing materials, maintains communication channels (digital and physical), supports club outreach, and ensures accurate documentation of meetings and committees. The ASGRCC Communications Coordinator works closely with RCC Marketing, Student Life, and ASGRCC leadership to maintain consistent and effective messaging across the college.



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Finance Coordinator Position Overview (10 hrs/wk):

The ASGRCC Finance Coordinator is responsible for managing, tracking, and communicating all financial activities of ASGRCC. This position ensures transparency, accuracy, and accountability in the use of student funds, works closely with Student Life and club leadership, and supports the ASGRCC Executive Council in budget planning and financial decision-making. The ASGRCC Finance Coordinator helps maintain compliance with ASGRCC bylaws, RCC financial procedures, and Zero-Based Budgeting practices.

Senator Position Overview (4 hrs/wk):

The ASGRCC Senator serves as an essential member of the student government's governance structure, acting as a representative voice for the student body in matters related to policy, legislation, and civic engagement. Senators support the work of the President by participating in committees, assisting with political and advocacy initiatives, and contributing to informed decision-making within the ASGRCC Council. This role helps promote student awareness of legislative issues, voter education, and campus advocacy efforts while maintaining strong communication with ASGRCC members, college personnel, and fellow students. Through active participation and reliable representation, the Senator helps ensure that student perspectives are reflected in campus governance and that students remain informed and engaged members of the RCC community.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be an enrolled RCC student meeting ASGRCC credit and GPA requirements (minimum cGPA of 2.50 and enrollment in at least six (6) RCC credits).
- Must maintain good academic and conduct standing throughout term of service
- Ability to attend required meetings and events
- Commitment to campus involvement and student leadership
- Availability for occasional evening or weekend programming

Term of Service

- Academic-year appointment (e.g., Fall–Spring)
- Renewable depending on performance and eligibility

Compensation or Benefits

- Stipend or hourly compensation
- Leadership and professional development
- Training and conference opportunities
- Early access to event-planning workshops or student leadership retreats
